



Standard Purchasing Terms and Conditions

The following Terms and Conditions for all purchase orders made by Designed Precision Castings Inc. (“DP Cast”) shall apply as appropriate

- a) Requirements for approval and release of products, services, processes, methods and equipment,
- b) Requirement for qualification personnel,
- c) Quality management system requirements,
- d) The identification and revision status of specifications, drawings, process requirements, inspection/verification instructions and other relevant technical data,
- e) Requirements for design, test, inspection, verifications (including production process verification), use of techniques for product acceptance, and related instructions for acceptance by the organization, and as applicable critical items including key characteristics,
- f) Requirements for ensuring that persons are aware of:
 1. Their contributions to product or service conformity,
 2. Their contribution to product safety,
 3. The importance of ethical behavior.
- g) Supplier is responsible to:
 1. Implement a quality management system,
 2. Use DP Cast designated or approved external providers, including process sources,
 3. Notify DP Cast of nonconforming product,
 4. Obtain DP Cast approval for non-conforming product disposition,
 5. Prevent the use of counterfeit parts,
 6. Notify the organization of changes in product and/or process, changes of supplier, changes of manufacturing facility location and, where required, obtain DP Cast approval, and,
 7. Flow down the supply chain the applicable requirements including customer requirements,
 8. Test specimens (e.g. production method, number, storage conditions) for design approval, inspection/verification, investigation or auditing.
- h) Record retention for 11 years, unless otherwise requested or required,
- i) Right of access by DP Cast, our customer and regulatory authorities to the applicable area of all facilities, at any level of the supply chain, involved in the order and to all applicable records.

The supplier shall ensure the adequacy of specified purchase requirements prior to their communication to their suppliers.
